The Cambridgeshire Rural Affordable housing partnership is an impartial party in bringing forward rural affordable housing.

Our work ensures that the community is provided for, and that any development meets the needs of the area.

Since 2013, 68 housing needs surveys have been undertaken by Cambridgeshire ACRE. As a result, almost 400 affordable homes across more than 30 schemes have been delivered for local people in rural communities

Our services include;



Explaining rural housing and the rural affordable housing process including:

- Housing tenures – shared ownership and affordable rent
- Local connection and allocation policies
- Rural Exception sites



Undertaking housing needs surveys to establish the need for affordable housing in your parish



Facilitating discussions with local authorities and housing association partners

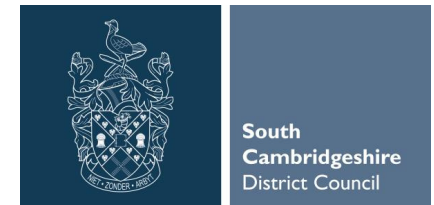
